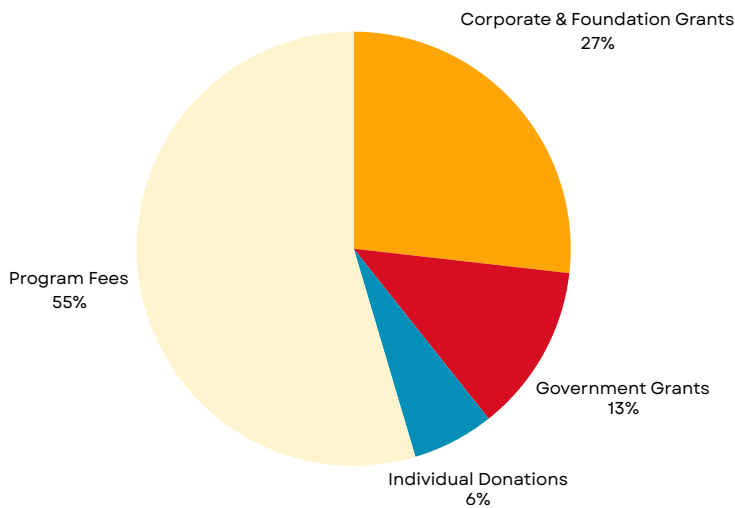

BUDGET SNAPSHOT

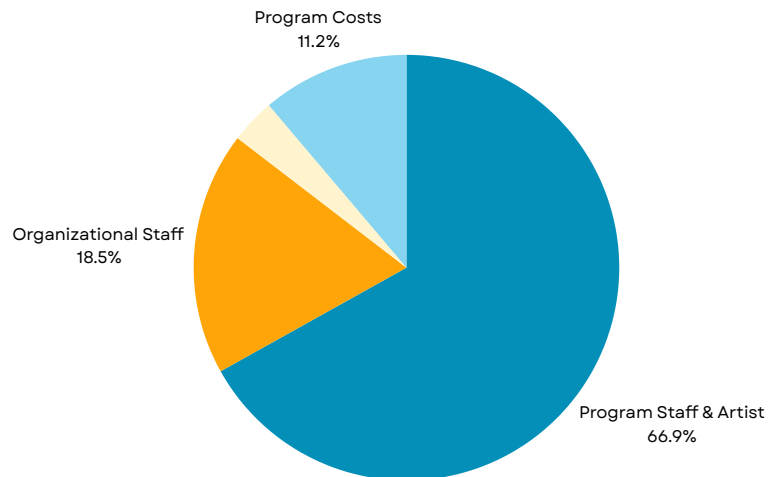
